### **Ecumenical Officer (East)**

The role of the Ecumenical Officer is to promote ecumenical working in the District. The Officer appointed for the East is responsible for the churches and circuits east of the M1, but the person in post will work in partnership with Anna Malnutt, who works in the western side of the District. There is a small group of committed people from the various denominations on the Enabling Group, which meets around three times a year. The group meets annually with the denominational leaders to review the working of LEPs in Nottinghamshire. The group is responsible for arranging reviews of the LEPs when called upon to do so. An Anglican member of the group Receives information from Churches Together in England, which he sends on to the rest of the group. The appointee will need to disseminate relevant news across the District. The Methodist Connexional Officers arrange an annual meeting for Ecumenical Officers. CTE also arranges a residential training conference for new officers. The main task of both Ecumenical Officers is to promote ecumenical working across the District as well as raising the profile of Methodism with other denominations.
