Overall Purpose:

- To advance the mission of the Church in the Circuits and Local Churches so we love God, love others and make disciples.
- To shape vision, determine strategy, formulate and promote policies, facilitate outworking of District policy intentions

Role Outline:

Alongside Standing Order 431, we are seeking someone to:

- Bring passion, creativity and missional thinking to the District Executive meetings.
- Formulate and promote policies from the District that enable our Circuits and Local Churches to “Love God, Love others and make disciples”.
- Critically analyse and creatively adapt the work of the District.
- Promote the District ethos in the Local Church and Circuit.

Availability:

- There will be monthly meetings, with an in-person quarterly meeting at the Rivergreen and shorter Zoom meetings in the other months. There is also substantial preparatory reading of reports before each meeting.

Accountability:

- At regular intervals, the District Executive will self-reflectively consider if it is fulfilling its overall purpose. Peer accountability will be part of this review.

Review:

- Work to be reviewed every 6 months collectively as the District Executive

Training:

- Training in visioning and strategic thinking is offered by the Learning Network.

Supervision and Support:

- Conversation with one of Deputy Chairs.

Expenses:

- Travel necessarily incurred in the performance of duties will be reimbursed.
Training materials will be provided or costs reimbursed.
